

Allotment Update

FIRE WARNING

As the current dry weather is predicted to last throughout the summer, we are reminding all our tenants to NOT use fire on the allotment site under any circumstances.

This includes the burning of rubbish and weeds (including weed burners) and social events, including any type of BBQ or lighting candles.

We are located in the centre of a wooded area and close to housing, as we have all seen on the extensive TV coverage, the damage that can be caused to buildings and other property by wild fires is extensive.

Please exercise extreme caution with any work you carry out on your allotment that involves any type of potential fire risk.

CONTROLLED WATER USAGE

With a hose pipe ban in our area, we would ask all tenants to control water usage on your plots.

Recently we have found that someone has been tampering with the water trough system and taking water covertly. We believe this has been for use outside of the allotment site. We have put new measures in place to control access to the water inflow systems.

We consider that such actions are theft of council property and as such can be reported to the police. We would ask them to take appropriate actions against any person found to be removing water from the site.

Any tenant found to be removing water without council approval will also have their tenancy terminated with immediate effect.

All tenants pay toward the cost of this water supply so please do not jeopardise this facility.
